## MINUTES OF THE SPECIAL COUNCIL MEETING CITY OF BROOKINGS OCTOBER 25, 1962

A copyrof a Letter from the County Roadmaster to Brookings Red-E-Mix concrete Co. was read, stating that the Company was to Look to the City of Brookings for payment of their bill for gravel used by the county on the county street allottment program, Amount of the bill being \$714.60.

A LETTER FROM THE STATE HIGHWAY DEPT., INFORMING THE COUNCIL THAT BASED UPON THE RESULTS OF THE INVESTIGATION FOR SIGNALIZATION ON CHETCO AVE., AT THE INTERSECTION OF OAK STREET AND HILLSIDE, THE REQUEST FOR SAID SIGNALS WAS REFUSED.
