

MINUTES OF THE SPECIAL COUNCIL MEETING  
CITY OF BROOKINGS  
OCTOBER 25, 1962

MEETING CALLED TO ORDER AT 8:00 P. M. MAYOR C. F. CAMPBELL PRESIDING.  
COUNCILMEN PRESENT; ERNEST CHRISTENSEN, LEROY WEIDEMAN, ROBERT DIMMICK,  
AND BEN FRANKLIN, JR.

THE MEETING WAS CALLED ORIGINALLY, FOR THE PURPOSE OF ACCEPTING THE RE-  
SIGNATION OF MAYOR C. F. CAMPBELL. HOWEVER, IN THAT HE WAS ADVISED NOT  
TO RESIGN BY CIVIL DEFENSE OFFICIALS, UNTIL CIVIL DEFENSE APPOINTMENTS  
HAD BEEN MADE, THE MATTER OF RESIGNATION WAS DEFERRED TEMPORARILY.

A REQUEST BY EUGENE W. LAWRENCE, TO OPERATE A TAXI-CAB SERVICE WAS REFERRED  
TO POLICE CHIEF, C. M. CROSS, FOR INVESTIGATION, THENCE TO BE SUBMITTED TO  
THE COUNCIL AT THE NEXT REGULAR MEETING TO BE HELD NOV. 13, 1962.

A COPY OF A LETTER FROM THE COUNTY ROADMASTER TO BROOKINGS RED-E-MIX  
CONCRETE Co. WAS READ, STATING THAT THE COMPANY WAS TO LOOK TO THE CITY  
OF BROOKINGS FOR PAYMENT OF THEIR BILL FOR GRAVEL USED BY THE COUNTY ON  
THE COUNTY STREET ALLOTMENT PROGRAM, AMOUNT OF THE BILL BEING \$714.60.

A LETTER FROM THE STATE HIGHWAY DEPT., INFORMING THE COUNCIL THAT BASED  
UPON THE RESULTS OF THE INVESTIGATION FOR SIGNALIZATION ON CHETCO AVE.,  
AT THE INTERSECTION OF OAK STREET AND HILLSIDE, THE REQUEST FOR SAID SIGNALS  
WAS REFUSED.

DOYLE RAUSCH, ASSISTANT CIVIL DEFENSE DIRECTOR, REPORTED ON THE CIVIL  
DEFENSE MEETING HELD IN GOLD BEACH. CONSIDERABLE DISCUSSION FOLLOWED  
REGARDING THE MATTER OF CIVIL DEFENSE.
