Minutes of Council Meeting

October 2, 1951

Meeting called to order at 8:00 P.M. by Mayor Dimmick.

Present were: Bob Dimmick, Warren Smith, Pete Lesmeister,
Chas. Young and Fred Fox

Visitors: Mr. McKenzie and Mr. Akers and
Mr. Echols.

Minutes of previous meeting read and approved.

Communications read and disposed of.

Mayor Dimmick appointed each councilman to a committee -
namely,

Pete Lesmeister	- Public Works
Chas. Young	- Planning and Zoning
Warren Smith	- Finance
Fred Fox	- Building regulations,
Robert Dimmick	- Police and Judge matters.

Warren Smith and Pete Lesmeister were requested to have something
to report on Finance at our next meeting.

Chas. Young felt that it would be good economy to merge the office
of City Recorder and City Judge.

Warren Smith said he felt that an emergency existed in connection
with the Finances and that ordinances governing city licenses should
be enacted as soon as possible.

Warren Smith made a motion that the mayor study the problem of a
city recorder and judge, and to try to contact some other city of
similar size as to their method on this. Seconded by Pete Lesmeister
all members voted in the affirmative.

Echols submitted 9 blue prints of various subdivisions upon which
were streets of various widths and would like the City Council to
approve these subdivisions for recording. These prints were left
in the hands of the council for consideration.

There being no other business, the meeting was adjourned until
Tuesday, 10/9/51 at 8:00 P.M.
