

MINUTES OF SPECIAL MEETING
OF THE CITY COUNCIL
OF BROOKINGS, OREGON, HELD

June 21, 1960

The Council met in a special session on June 21, 1960 at 9:30 P. M.

Present were Mayor C. F. Campbell; Councilmen: Gordon Goetz, Lee Hein, and Recorder, Cavens.

Ernest Christensen was appointed to fill the vacancy on the City Council created by the resignation of Councilman Phetteplace. Motion was made by Councilman Goetz, seconded by Councilman Hein that his appointment be approved. The motion was carried. Councilman Christensen was then sworn into office by the Recorder.

Mayor Campbell gave a brief resume of the duties of a Councilman and welcomed Councilman Christensen to the official body of the City of Brookings. Councilman Goetz and Councilman Hein pointed out additional duties and some of the responsibilities of the position.

Mayor Campbell read the results of the election as handed in by the election clerks of the three precincts. The results were as follows:

Measure No. 4 carried with a total of 204 For and 122 Against. Advisory Ballot on the dog leash law passed with a total of 206 For and 114 Against.

The City Council then gave much time and discussion to the city budget. The Budget Committee members present were: N. W. Bergstrom, J. R. Yelton, Arthur Knox and Emmett Gulley.

The Council accepted the Budget as presented and the Recorder was authorized to give it to the Brookings Harbor Pilot for publication. A public hearing of the budget will be held July 12, at the regular council meeting at 8:00 P. M.

Councilman Hein moved that whereas the voters turned down the measure for street improvements and that the sewer program has been temporarily delayed that the services of Mr. H. E. Echols be terminated as of July 15, 1960, and that his services be utilized when needed on a part time bases. The motion was seconded by Councilman Goetz. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Councilman Hein and seconded by Councilman Goetz that the meeting adjourn until June 28 at 7:30 P. M. Motion carried.
