

MINUTES OF SPECIAL MEETING

Of City Council

OF BROOKINGS, OREGON, HELD

September 19, 1960

The council met in special session on September 19, 1960.

Meeting called to order by Mayor Campbell presiding.

Councilmen present were Hanks, Goetz, Hein and Christensen. Others present were Swatzel, Marje Barrett, Chief Kerr, Grayshel, Sam Hall, Jenkins, Al Mincer, Wheeler & McVay.

The purpose of the meeting was to discuss the Mutual Aid Fire Agreement between Harbor and Brookings. Mayor Campbell led the discussion followed by Sam Hall, Lee Hein, Bob Kerr and others.

Mr. Grayshel stated that if the City of Brookings and the community of Harbor could work out a mutual aid contract that the City of Brookings insurance rate would drop to Class 7 instead of Class 8. Mr. Mincer stated that the community of Harbor was planning to buy another truck as soon as the present one was paid for.

Sam Hall suggested that the two bodies draw up a Fire Contract to present to the council and the Harbor Community Fire Board. The following committee was appointed: Swatzel, Jenkins, Balderree, and the fire board of Harbor's attorney.

Councilman Christensen suggested that the minutes of the meetings be read on the air to inform the general public of what was going on at the meetings.

Mr. Swatzel gave an itemized account of Mr. Echols time during the month of August. Mr. Swatzel suggested that the account be paid as presented. Councilman Christensen moved that the account be paid, seconded by Hein. Motion carried.

Mr. Swatzel gave a report on Mr. Baumgartner's property stating that the city should give a letter to Mr. Baumgartner stating that if and when he sub-divided his property that the city will put in a sewer main to serve the area.

Mr. Swatzel read a letter from the County Commissioner asking that an agreement be executed pertaining to the work done and to be done on Park View Drive. Motion made by Councilman Goetz, seconded by Councilman Hein that the Mayor be authorized to execute the agreement. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Councilman Christensen, seconded by Councilman Goetz that the meeting be adjourned. Motion carried.
