We do hereby waive any and all requirements of the statutes of the State of Oregon and the Charter of the City of Brookings as to the notice of this meeting and the publication thereof and we do consent to the transaction of such business as may come before said meeting and more particularly and specifically the consideration of the offer from the County Court and Curry County in regard to roads and streets.

Waiver of notice and consent of the holding of this meeting signed by all members of the Council and the Mayor of the City was regularly presented by the recorder and duly entered.

The Council was called to order by the Honorable Mayor Robert Dimmick and the recorder noted that all Councilmen were present except P. J. Lesmeister and all had signed waiver of notice of this special meeting.

Thereupon the Honorable Mayor presented to the Council the offer made by the County Court of Curry County in response to the petition and request of this Council that the County of Curry surrender to the City of Brookings a title to and jurisdiction over all County roads within the corporate limits of the City of Brookings, save and excepting the road known as AZALEA PARK ROAD.

He stated that this offer was presented in the form of a certified copy of the resolution and order of Curry County Court, certified to by Oleta A. Walker, Clerk of said Court, and delivered to this City in Council, that is, to the recorder of the City of Brookings by R. G. Sabin, ~~by~~ ~~Deputy~~ Sheriff of Curry County.

Thereupon Councilman Smith offered the following resolution and moved its adoption.

WHEREAS, The County Court of Curry County has offered to surrender to the City of Brookings jurisdiction over all County roads or any portion thereof, that are within the corporate limits of the

3 NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED That this City of Brookings,
4 Oregon, a MUNICIPAL CORPORATION acting by and through its City Council,
5 does hereby accept the offer of Curry County Court, dated the 6th day
6 of February, 1952, to surrender to the City of Brookings jurisdiction
7 over all County roads or any portion thereof, that are within the
8 corporate limits of the City of Brookings, save and excepting that
9 road known as AZALEA PARK ROAD, by which acceptance this City of
10 Brookings has assumed full and absolute jurisdiction over said County
11 roads within the corporate limits of said City for all purposes of
12 repair, construction, and improvement and the levying and collection
13 of assessments therefore and all control, power, and jurisdiction over
14 the same as given this City by its Charter and the laws of the State
15 of Oregon.
