## SPECIAL COUNCIL MEETING August 1st. 1952

Meeting called to order by Mayor Dimmick at 8;30 P.M. Councilmen present: Lesmeister, Fox, Young, & Smith. hers present: Chief Brown, Attorney Hall, & City Recorder Kanick.

Reading of the previous minutes waived until next regular meeting.

Ordinance #26 introduced and read by Attorney Hall, entitled: "AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO TRAFFIC? CREATING A PARKING METER ZONE, PLACING LIMITATIONS UPON PARKING IN SAID ZONE, N PROVIDING FOR the INSTALL-ATION, REGULATION AND CONTROL OF THE USE OF PARKING METERS AND SAID PARKING AUTHORIZING A METHOD OF PAYMENT METER ZONE, PROVIDING FOR PARKING FEES, FOR PARKING METERS AND ALLIED EQUIPMENT AND THE INSTALLATION THEREOF EXCLU-SIVELY FROM THE RECEIPTS OBTAINED FROM THEIR OPERATION, PROVIDING FOR EN-FORCEMENT THEREOF, FIXING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF, PROVIDING THAT INVALIDITY OF PART SHALL NOT AFFECT THE VALIDITY OF THE REMAINDER THEREOF, REPEALING PARAGRAPH (a ) OF SECTION 14 OF ORDINANCE NO. 10, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY!

Motion was made by Councilman Fox, seconded by Councilman Young that said Ordinance #26, be read in full once, twice by title, and passed at this meeting of the council. A poll of councilmen as follows passed the motion nance unanimously: Fox, aye, Lesmeister, aye and Young, aye. Smith, aye.

Whereupon Ordinance #26 was read as directed by attorney Hall, and passed by the following vote: Smith, aye, Lesmeister, aye, Young, aye, and Fox, aye. corder was directed to send copy to State Highway Engineer, R.H. Baldock at Salem with appropriate letter.

Mayor Dimmick advised that Mr. Bankus had asked for an increase in water rates and wanted to discuss these propsed rates with the city council and get it's viewpoint in the matter. It was decided to hold a meeting with him in the near future and have an expert or qualified water man present at said meeting.

Matter of appointing a Judge pro-tem to replace Mr. Guerretz, resigned was discussed. It was decided to contact, Clyde Manley in regard to his accepting this office, and make the appointment at a later meeting.
