

SPECIAL COUNCIL MEETING
September 30, 1952

Meeting called to order by Mayor Dimmick

Present: Councilmen Lesmeister, Fox and Young and City Atty. Hall.

Mrs. Mary Jane Brimm presented for approval, the application of Don's Cliff House, Inc. for a class "C" restaurant liquor license, to which was attached exhibit "D" showing the process of formation of this corporation.

After reviewing the matter, it was moved by Councilman Young and seconded by Councilman Fox that the application of Don's Cliff House, Inc. be approved. A vote of 4 to 0 carried the motion unanimously. Councilman Smith was absent.

A discussion was held on the Mayor's interview with Elmer Bankus regarding the fire hydrant matter.

After reviewing the Hurst-Johnson building case, it was moved by Mr. Young, and seconded by Mr. Fox that the recorder or mayor send a letter to Mr. & Mrs. Hurst and Mr. Johnson stating that the position of the city council is that they remove that portion of their building which extends into the alley and that if they will submit plans for an overlap of the second story, the city will give it consideration.

On motion by Mr. Fox, meeting adjourned.
