6RDINANCE #13, entitled: "AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR PUBLIC IMPROVEMENTS, AND THE ACQUISITION OF LAND BY CONDEMNATION OR OTHERWISE, PROVIDING THE MANNER OF PAYMENT THEREFOR, AND THE LEVYING AND COLLECTION OF SPECIAL ASSESS-MENTS UPON PROPERTY SPECIALLY BENEFITED THEREBY, PROVIDING FOR BIDS UPON CONTRACT FOR PUBLIC IMPROVEMENTS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY."

ORDINANCE # 山 , entitled:" AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING THE PROCEDURE FOR CREATING AN IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY."

ORDINANCE # 45, entitled; "AN OBDINANCE PROVIDING THE PROCEDURE FOR LEVYING AND COLLECTIN SPECIAL ASSESSMENTS UPON PROPERTY SPECIALLY BENEFITED BY ANY PUBLIC IMPROVEMENT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY."

ORDINANCE # 46, entitled; "AN ORDINANCE CREATING A SPECIAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT, PROVIDING FOR THE PAYMENT THEREFOR, DESIGNATING THE PROPERTIES TO BE SPECIALLY BENEFITED THEREBY, LEVYING A SPECIAL ASSESSMENT UPON SAID PROPERTIES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY."
