

MINUTES OF THE SPECIAL MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL  
June 16, 1954

Meeting called to order by Acting Mayor, Warren Smith.

Present: Councilman Lesmeister, Campbell and Manley.

Officers present: Recorder Kanick.

Regulation of the height of fences and limiting to six feet discussed. <sup>BY ME</sup>

Motion was made by Mr. Lesmeister and seconded by Mr. Manley that Ord. #62 be read in full once, twice by title and passed at this meeting of the council. Campbell, aye; Lesmeister, aye; and Manley, aye. Carried.

Whereupon Ordinance # 62 entitled: " AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NUMBER 19, SECTION 16, OF THE CITY OF BROOKINGS: PROVIDING A LIMITATION UPON THE HEIGHT AND CONSTRUCTION OF FENCES HEREAFTER ERECTED WITHIN THE CITY OF BROOKINGS, OREGON, UPON USE DISTRICTS AS THE SAME ARE SET FORTH IN SECTION 12, OF SAID ORDINANCE NO. 19, AND THEREIN DESIGNATED AS R-1, R-2, R-3, and C-1: REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH: AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY," was read in full once, twice by title and passed by the following vote: Campbell, aye, Lesmeister, aye; and Manley, aye.

Motion was made by Mr. Manley that Council adjourn until July 13th.
