Old Buisness:

Grayshell Bldg. Sidewalk:

Mr. Grayshell presented a profile of situation of non conforming sidewalk in front of Grayshell Bldg. Said reason it had not been taken care of ^{this} time is the tenants were having a sale and asked not to be disturbed. Mr. Weiderman asked a delay on improving said sidewalk, in as much as it isn't a Great hazard. Work on Palmer Bldg. taking all his men. Motion by Mr. Manly seconded by Yelton. Mr. Manly reports he has been unable to collect any funds from them.


N_ew Recorded's salary to start at \$230.00 per month.
