

Minutes of the City Council Meeting August 23rd, 1955

Meeting called to order by Mayor Brimm.

Councilmen Present; Messrs Campbell, Yelton, Manley, Breuer.

Officers Present: Attor. Ackley, Supt. Reed, Mae D. Smith.

Others Present: Messrs Mendenhall, Murphy, Cross, Thompson.

Minutes of meeting of August 9th, read and approved.

Minutes of special meeting of August 16th, read and approved.

Mr. Ackley reported, he had talked to a representative of the firm of Cornell, Howland, Hayes and Merryfield. They thought there would be no difficulty in getting deferred payments on a water survey, for the City of Brookings. Mr. Rice will call Mr. Reed and arrange a meeting to arrive at some solution.

Letter from Mr. Shaw was read. Mr. Shaw represents the Beresa Tract. The matter between the Beresa people has been straightened out.

Hospital:

Mr. Campbell reported, Dr. Ronninger had given up the idea of building a clinic in connection with his clinic. Dr. Ronninger mentioned a tract of land in Harbor. Mr. Campbell will continue to work on the project. There are several plots of land that might be gotten.

No answer from the Speed Control Board.

Del Norte District:

Mr. Reed reported, there were sixty seven (67) signatures out of approximately one hundred twenty (120) property owners who had signed the petitions. Motion by Mr. Manley, seconded Mr. Yelton, the City Council approve the procedure of the City Engineer's office on sewers, paving and maps of the assessed district. The district to be known as district #1. Carried.

Motion by Mr. Breuer seconded Mr. Campbell the City pay off the note and interest on the fire truck. Amount \$3156.56. Carried.

The recorder was instructed to send a statement to the Red-E-Mix for \$12.00 they owe the city.

The recorder was also instructed to write the League of Oregon Cities about the street sweeper.

Motion Mr. Manley, seconded Mr. Breuer, Mr. Thompson, the Postmaster, contact the Planning Commission about placing out side mail boxes. Carried.

Recorder to notify Mr. Thompson as to when the next meeting of the Planning Commission will be.

Mr. Thompson complained about the water running in front of the P.O. Bldg. The water runs down on the side walk and makes it hard to get into the P.O. Mr. Kerr is to see Hi-Way Dept. about same.

Mr. Yelton suggested, the newspaper print ^{all} emergence telephone numbers in a form so they could be placed in a ^{convenient} place near the telephones.

House numbers were discussed. Some samples were shown and one was selected. Motion by Mr. Yelton, seconded Mr. Beuer, Mr. Reed order the numbers and make arrangements with the Boy Scouts to place the numbers.

No licenses report:

Chief Cross Report:

Chief Cross had talked to Mr. Nickels about building and taking care of a dog pound. Mr. Nickels would take care of the pound and picking up of the dogs for a fee of \$10.00 every other week. Motion by Mr. Breuer, the dog license fee to pay for the impounding of the dogs and the expense involved in enforcing collection of dog licenses. The surplus to be put in the general fund each year. Seconded by Mr. Manley. Carried.

Parking Meters:

Chief Cross to meet with the Planning Commission about placing more parking meters.

Chief Cross and Mr. Reed to get together about painting crosswalks.

Mr. Ackley called attention to the need of a truck route thru the City. Referred to the Planning Commission.

Copy of letter from Mr. Gerow, State Board of Health, to Mr Ackley was read.

Fire Chief Mendenhall, reported two fires in Harbor,, at \$25.00 each. The rural area in the vicinity of Parkview Dr. Dodge and Dawson want fire protection. Mr mendenhall to work out something with Mr. Ackley.

A discussion followed about Mayor Brimm going to see Mr. Shuler in Portland. Motion by Mr. Breuer, seconded Mr. Yelton, a meeting between Mr. Shular and Mayor Brimm be arranged at the earliest possible date. The expense to be paid by the City. Carried. *payed own expense*

Telephone bills read. Motion by Mr Breuer, seconded Mr. Manley, the bills be approved. Carried.

These names were presented by the Mayor, to the Council as appointments of trustees for the Cheto Community Public Library, to serve as follows. One year Mrs. Arthur Knox, two years Mrs Jessie Judkins and Jack Mc Carton, three years Ben Jones, four years M.S. Brainard. Motion by Mr. Campbell seconded Mr. Manley, the Council approve the Mayors appointments of the Library Board of Trustees. Carried.






