

Minutes of Special Meeting of the City Council

September 6th 1955

Meeting called to order by Mayor Brimm.

Councilmen Present: Messrs: Yelton, Campbell, Breuer.

Officers Present: Attor. Ackley, Supt. Reed, Mae D. Smith.

Others Present: Mrs. Mildred Burns, Messrs. Piserek, Mc Kenzie, Hendricks Stanhurst, and Rice.

Mr. Rice of the firm of Cornell- Hayes- Howland and Merryfield, was present to discuss the survey of the water system.

Mr. Bankus who owns the present water system, was unable to attend the meeting and was represented by Mrs. Burns. Mrs Burns stated Mr Bankus was willing to sell the water system and willing to cooperate one hundred percent with the firm of Cornell-Hayes- Howland and Merryfield, but due to some misunderstanding on the sewer appraisal, Mr. Bankus wanted a complete understanding with the engineers as to the methods to be used.

Mr. Rice stated he was willing to meet with Mr. Bankus and put in writing what they would on the survey.

Mr. Hendricks, chairman of the budget committee said he thought the cost of the survey could be put in the next years budget.

It was decided by the Councilmen present, to have a contract drawn to pay the engineering firm \$2,000.00 when that much work had been completed and the balance of \$4700.00 to be paid July 1st 1956. Final decision to be made and contract be signed at regular meeting of the Council Sept. 13th.


Mr. Ackley to look over the contract.

Bond issue was discussed.

Mr. Rice suggested the \$30,000.00 to purchase the sewer system be \$10,000.00 General Obligation bonds and \$20,000.00 be Special assessment bonds. He also sugessted a sewer rate be worked out and the charge to start as soon as the sewer system is aquired by the City. This sum to be put in a fund for maintenance etc. Mr. Rice will compute figuers on the sewer charge and send them to the Council in about two weeks.
