

MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING OF THE
CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
BROOKINGS, OREGON

October 13, 1956

Meeting called to order by Mayor Brimm.

Councilmen present: Messrs. Manley and Campbell.

Others present: Mr. Reed and Bud Pisarek

The Council considers sealed bids for Series 1956 City of Brookings Improvement Bonds for \$76,888.65 as follows:

1. The United States National Bank of Portland Four and One-Half Percent (4 1/2%), effective interest rate 4.4697%. Quoted price \$100.17.
2. The First National Bank Four Percent (4%), effective interest rate 3.9768. Quoted price \$100.13.

After the Council had heard the bids read and considered the same, Councilman Campbell moved that the low legal bid of the First National Bank be accepted and that the certified check of the United States National Bank be returned to the bank. This motion was seconded by Councilman Manley. Motion carried.

A letter from the Terrace Drive-In Theatre was read to the council requesting a fire protection agreement with the Brookings Fire Department. A motion was made by Councilman Manley and seconded by Councilman Campbell that the city enter into an agreement with the Terrace Drive In for \$50.00 a year. Motion carried.

A letter from the Public Utilities Commissioner was read in regard to Proposed Ordinance No. 96. The council will decide on this matter at the council meeting to be held November 13, 1956.

A copy of a letter written by the County Judge to the Oregon State Highway Commission with reference to the heavy log traffic from North Bank was read to the Council.

Also, a letter from the Oregon State Highway Commission with reference to the city's letter of September 17, 1956, which requested that U.S. Highway 101 be resurfaced between Pacific Street and the city limits to the east was read to the council.

A motion was made by Councilman Campbell and seconded by Councilman Manley that the meeting be recessed until November 8 at 7:00 P.M. for the purpose of hearings on the Reassessment Districts.
