Acting by and Through its State Highway Commission, for the Improvement
of Pioneer Road from Pacific Avenue to Easy Street and for the Improvement
of Easy Street from Pioneer Road Westerly for Approximately 335 Feet, in
all a Distance of Approximately 0.20 Mile and Declaring an Emergency.
