Meeting called to order by Mayor Campbell.

Councilmen present: Messrs. Breuer and Hein.

Others present: Gordon Goetz, Al Phillips and R. H. Erichsen.

A motion was made by Councilman Breuer and seconded by Councilman Hein that Resolution No. 30 as submitted by the State Highway Department regarding encroachment of the Oregon State Highway No. 199 in the City of Brookings be accepted. Motion carried unanimously.

There was some discussion of a state truck weighing station on Chetco Avenue just past Pacific Avenue. Councilman Breuer suggested that the City Recorder check the minutes for prior discussion on this problem regarding committments to Elmer Bankus in connection with an access road adjoining the highway at that point.

It was moved by Councilman Breuer and seconded by Councilman Hein that the City enter into a contract with R. H. Erichsen, Consulting Engineer, for the design and inspection of the City's Sewage Disposal Plant and additional sewer installations. Motion carried unanimously.

A letter from the State Water Resources Department in regard to the City's application for appropriation of water rights from the Chetco River was read. The council recommended that we request a form for extension of time on this project.

A motion was made to adjourn until December 10.
