

MINUTES OF SPECIAL MEETING

OF THE CITY COUNCIL

OF THE CITY OF BROOKINGS

March 21, 1957

Meeting called to order by Mayor Campbell.

Councilmen present: Messrs. Breuer, Phetteplace, Hein and Hanks.

Purpose of meeting was to transfer fund and truck sale.

A motion was made by Councilman Phetteplace and seconded by Councilman Breuer that the City Engineer and Special Survey Fund be transferred to the Capitol Outlay Fund. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Councilman Breuer and seconded by Councilman Hanks that the city purchase a used Adams grader from Brizard-Matthews for \$5000.00 plus old grader subject to trial by City of Brookings. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Councilman Phetteplace and seconded by Councilman Breuer that a delegation of two or three people from Brookings attend the State sale at Salem and submit bids on equipment adaptable for maintenance of Brookings streets and that a maximum of \$2,200.00 be made available for the purchase of such equipment. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Councilman Breuer and seconded by Councilman Phetteplace that the meeting be adjourned.
