## MINUTES OF SPECIAL MEETING OF THE BROOKINGS CITY COUNCIL HELD JUNE 25, 1957

Meeting called to order by Mayor Campbell.

Councilmen present: Messrs. Hein, Breuer, Phetteplace and Hanks.

A motion was made by Councilman Breuer and seconded by Councilman Phetteplace that the hearing for the 1957-58 budget be set for July 18, 1957, and that the City Recorder be authorized to apply to the County Assessor for an extension to July 25 before a Notice of Tax Levy is mailed to him.
