## OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF BROOKINGS, OREGON, HELD August 13, 1957

Meeting called to order by Mayor Campbell.

Councilman present: Messrs. Breuer, Hanks, Phetteplace and Hein.

Others present: Chief Cross, Attorney Balderree, Mr. Hysom, Joseph Murphy, Mike Page, and Hans Nelson.

Minutes of meetings of July 9, 18 and 23rd were read and approved.

A letter from Shady Beard in regard to his unsafe fireplace was read. Councilman Hanks was appointed to investigate the matter to determine just what can be done in these cases.

Chief Cross reported that the crosswalk markers had not been ordered and will not be until the general fund finances are available.

The council decided to curb expenses until the city receives the first turnover of tax money.

There was considerable discussion in regard to the advisability of voting a bond issue to build the disposal plant. Gordon Goetz, Earl Breuer, Murray Palmer, Richard L. Smith, Clarence Kruger, Harold Young, Forest Hysom, Walter Sadler, Frede Steinmetz and Mr. Waller were appointed by the Mayor to investigate the matter.

The council requested the City Attorney to write a letter to Mr. Paul Taylor and ask him to sign the easement forwarded to him.

Mr. Page presented a bill from the Brookings Water Company received by the Boy Scouts. Mr. Page was protesting the excessive amount of the bill. The council advised him to take the matter up with the Public Utilities Commission.

Mr. Hysom was present as a representative from the Planning Commission to request the presence of the City Attorney at the Planning Commission meetings, requested that a copy of the City Council minutes be forwarded to them and asked that a representative from the Planning Commission be allowed to sit in on the council meetings.

A letter of resignation from Charles Echols was read. A motion was made by Councilman Breuer and seconded by Councilman Phetteplace that the city accept the resignation of Mr. Echols. Motion carried. The City Recorder was instructed to forward a letter of appreciation to Mr. Echols.

The bills were presented. A motion was made by Councilman Phetteplace and seconded by Councilman Breuer that the bills be paid. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Councilman Phetteplace and seconded by Councilman Breuer that the meeting be adjourned.
