## MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING

## OF THE CITY COUNCIL

## OF BROOKINGS, OR EGON, HELD

OCTOBER 14, 1958

THE COUNCIL MET IN REGULAR SESSION OCTOBER 14, 1958, AT 8 O'CLOCK P.M.

PRESENT WERE MAYOR CAMPBELL, COUNCILMEN HEIN, BREUER, GULLEY AND HANKS, ATTORNEY BALDERREE, RECORDER HUDDLESTON, SUPT. SPENCER, CHIEF CROSS, JAMES KIRBY, R. H. ERICHSEN, Mr. BUFFINTON, AND OTHERS.

MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETINGS HELD ON SEPTEMBER 9, SEPTEMBER 16 AND SEPTEMBER 23 WERE READ AND APPROVED.

THE CITY RECORDER OPENED AND THE COUNCIL CONSIDERED BIDS FOR THE SEWAGE TREATMENT PLANT AS FOLLOWS:

AFTER THE COUNCIL HAD HEARD THE BIDS READ AND CONSIDERED THE SAME, COUNCILMAN BREUER MOVED THAT THE LOW LEGAL BID OF SCHROEDER PLUMBING AND HEATING IN THE AMOUNT OF \$91,328.00 PLUS EQUIPMENT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$14,640.00 AS RECOMMENDED BY THE ENGINEER BE ACCEPTED. THIS MOTION WAS SECONDED BY COUNCILMAN HEIN.

MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

THE CITY RECORDER OPENED AND THE COUNCIL CONSIDERED THE FOLLOWING BIDS FOR CITY OF BROOKINGS SEWAGE DISPOSAL BONDS, SERIES OF 1958, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$150,000.00:

- 1. U. S. NATIONAL BANK JOINTLY SUBMITTED WITH BLYTH AND COMPANY, NET INTEREST COST OF \$84,315.00, OR AN EFFECTIVE INTEREST RATE OF 4.3238.
- 2. FOSTER & MARSHALL, NET INTEREST COST OF \$86,610.00, OR AN EFFECTIVE INTEREST RATE OF 4.4415.
- 3. FIRST NATIONAL BANK OF PORTLAND, NET INTEREST COST OF \$88,770.00 OR AN EFFECTIVE INTEREST RATE OF 4.552.

AFTER THE COUNCIL HAD HEARD THE BIDS READ AND CONSIDERED THE SAME, COUNCILMAN HEIN MOVED THAT THE LOW LEGAL BID OF U. S. NATIONAL BANK JOINTLY SUBMITTED WITH BLYTH AND COMPANY FOR A NET INTEREST COST OF \$84,315.00 OR AN EFECTIVE INTEREST RATE OF 4.328 BE ACCEPTED AND THAT THE CERTIFIED CHECKS OF THE OTHER BIDDERS BE RETURNED TO THEM. THIS MOTION WAS SECONDED BY COUNCILMAN BREVER.

MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

CHIEF CROSS REPORTED ON THE TRAFFIC PROBLEM ON MILL STREET AND REQUESTED THAT PARALLEL PARKING BE ENFORCED. HE WAS INSTRUCTED TO PRESENT THE MATTER TO THE PLANNING COMMISSION FOR THEIR CONSIDERATION AND RECOMMENDATION.

A LETTER FROM MRS. CLARENCE WHITAKER, PRESIDENT OF THE PTA IN REGARD TO THE PEDESTRIAN PROBLEM ON OAK STREET WAS READ. THE CITY RECORDER WAS INSTRUCTED TO WRITE A LETTER TO THE PTA THANKING THEM FOR THEIR OFFER TO HELP IN THIS PROBLEM AND TELL THEM THAT WE WERE NOT IN A POSITION TO START ANYTHING ON IT NOW BUT WOULD CALL ON THEM FOR THEIR ASSISTANCE AT A LATER DATE.

A LETTER FROM EMMETT GULLEY RESIGNING AS A MEMBER OF THE PLANNING COMMISSION WAS READ. A MOTION WAS MADE BY COUNCILMAN HEIN AND SECONDED BY COUNCILMAN BREUER TO ACCEPT THE RESIGNATION. MOTION CARRIED.

A TRANSFER OF PIPE LINE PERMIT NO. 4060 AND A PIPE LINE PERMIT AGREEMENT FOR WORK TO BE DONE ON THE SEWER NEAR THE BANK AND THE KLISE PROPERTY WAS PRESENTED. A MOTION WAS MADE BY COUNCILMAN HEIN AND SECONDED BY COUNCILMAN BREUER THAT THE MAYOR AND CITY RECORDER BE AUTHORIZED TO EXECUTE THE AGREEMENTS. MOTION CARRIED.

ORDINANCE NO. 120, VACATING A PORTION OF SEVENTH STREET WAS READ THE SECOND
TIME FULLY AND DISTINCTLY AT LENGTH. A MOTION WAS MADE BY COUNCILMAN BREUER
AND SECONDED BY COUNCILMAN HANKS THAT SAID ORDINANCE NO. 120 BE ADOPTED. MOTION
CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

SEWER DISTRICT No. 8 WAS DISCUSSED. THE CITY RECORDER WAS INSTRUCTED TO NOTIFY THE PROPERTY OWNERS IN THAT DISTRICT OF THE INTENTION OF THE COUNCIL TO ADOPT AN ORDINANCE ON THIS DISTRICT AS REVISED AND RECOMMENDED BY THE CITY ENGINEER.

A PLAN FOR THE EXTENSION OF FIFTH STREET WAS PRESENTED. THE COUNCIL INSTRUCTED THE RECORDER TO FORWARD THE PLAN TO THE PLANNING COMMISSION FOR THEIR APPROVAL.

ATTORNEY BALDERREE REQUESTED PERMISSION FROM THE COUNCIL TO PREPARE AN ORDINANCE NAMING THE COUNCIL POSITIONS. THE COUNCIL GAVE HIM AUTHORITY TO PREPARE THIS ORDINANCE.
