

MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING
OF THE CITY COUNCIL
HELD IN BROOKINGS, OREGON,
ON DECEMBER 9, 1958

THE COUNCIL MET IN REGULAR SESSION DECEMBER 9, 1958, AT 8 O'CLOCK P.M.

PRESENT WERE MAYOR CAMPBELL, COUNCILMEN HEIN, BREUER, GULLEY AND HANKS, CHIEF CROSS, BILL SPENCER, JUDGE KIRBY, RECORDER HUDDLESTON, GORDON GOETZ AND OTHERS.

THE MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING HELD ON NOVEMBER 12, 1958, AND THE SPECIAL MEETING HELD ON DECEMBER 1, 1958, WERE READ AND APPROVED.

MAYOR CAMPBELL REPORTED ON HIS TELEPHONE CONVERSATION WITH A. M. GEORGE.

A BID ON A LEROY AIR COMPRESSOR FROM D. B. ALLSUP WAS READ. A MOTION WAS MADE BY COUNCILMAN HEIN AND SECONDED BY COUNCILMAN GULLEY THAT THE BID OF D. B. ALLSUP IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,560.00 ON A LEROY AIR COMPRESSOR BE ACCEPTED. MOTION CARRIED.

AN APPLICATION AND RESOLUTION FOR STATE APPROPRIATION FOR PAVING WAS PRESENTED. CENTER STREET WAS DISCUSSED IN REGARD TO PAVING, HOWEVER, THE COUNCIL DECIDED TO PRESENT THE APPLICATION TO THE PLANNING COMMISSION FOR THEIR RECOMMENDATION.

A LETTER DATED DECEMBER 9, 1958, FROM THE CHAMBER OF COMMERCE IN REGARD TO TELEPHONE SERVICE WAS READ. THE RECORDER WAS INSTRUCTED TO SEND A COPY OF THE LETTER TO THE COOS BAY TELEPHONE OFFICE AND ASK THAT THEY ADVISE THE CITY THE STATUS OF THE MICRO WAVE SYSTEM BEING INSTALLED.

A LETTER DATED DECEMBER 9, 1958, FROM THE PLANNING COMMISSION IN REGARD TO THE HEARING FOR REZONING WAS READ. THE RECORDER WAS INSTRUCTED TO REQUEST A FORMAL RECOMMENDATION ON THE REZONING BEFORE THE COUNCIL TAKES ANY ACTION ON THE MATTER.

THE MAYOR REQUESTED THE COUNCIL'S APPROVAL OF RICHARD TOWNSEND TO BE APPOINTED AS A MEMBER OF THE PLANNING COMMISSION. THEREUPON A MOTION WAS MADE BY COUNCILMAN HEIN AND SECONDED BY COUNCILMAN BREUER THAT RICHARD TOWNSEND BE APPOINTED TO SERVE ON THE PLANNING COMMISSION UNTIL APRIL 21, 1959. MOTION CARRIED.

MAYOR CAMPBELL INFORMED THE COUNCIL THAT SCHROEDER PLUMBING AND HEATING WANTED THE COUNCIL'S APPROVAL OF THREE PHASE POWER ON THE DISPOSAL PLANT. THE RECORDER WAS INSTRUCTED TO WRITE A LETTER TO MR. ERICHSEN FOR HIS APPROVAL ON THE MATTER.

CROSSWALK SIGNS WERE DISCUSSED. CHIEF CROSS WAS INSTRUCTED TO OBTAIN MORE INFORMATION ON THEM.

THE SALE OF THE OLD POLICE CAR WAS ALSO DISCUSSED. THE COUNCIL AGREED TO SELL THE CAR FOR \$1200.00 TO \$1250.00.

THE TAXI FRANCHISE WAS DISCUSSED. THE RECORDER WAS INSTRUCTED TO WRITE A LETTER TO MR. MORROW WHO NOW HOLDS THE FRANCHISE AND REQUEST THAT HE BE PRESENT AT THE COUNCIL MEETING TO BE HELD JANUARY 13, 1958, TO SHOW CAUSE WHY THE FRANCHISE SHOULD BE NOT CANCELED.

MR. EBINGER WAS PRESENT TO DISCUSS A POSSIBLE RELOCATION OF HIGHWAY 101.
