MINUTES OF SPECIAL MEETING

OF THE CITY COUNCIL

OF BROOKINGS, OREGON, HELD

May 15, 1958

The council met in special session at 8:00 o'clock, May 15, 1958.

Present were Mayor Campbell, Councilmen Hein and Hagen and Bill Spencer.

The meeting was called for the purpose of holding a hearing on the 1958-59 budget and a hearing to rezone Lot 72 and Lots 73 to 82 inclusive of the Thornton and Ward Tract.

There being no one present to oppose the budget a motion was made by Councilman Hein that the 1958-59-Budget as recommended by the Budget Committee at its meeting of March 10, 1958, be adopted in the amount of \$494,654.00, and the amount of \$34,837.00, as provided in said budget be raised by taxation for the purpose of deferring various expenses of the City for the period of July 1, 1958, to June 30, 1959. The motion was seconded by Councilman Hagen and carried. A motion was made by Councilman Hein that the City of Brookings appropriate for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1958, and ending June 30, 1959 funds for each office or officer, department, street and other purpose as outlined in the budget. The motion was seconded by Councilman Hagen and carried.

A motion was made by Councilman Hagen and seconded by Councilman Hein that Lots 72 to 82 inclusive of the Thornton and Ward Tract be rezoned from M-L and Ag-1 to R-3. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Councilman Hagen and seconded by Councilman Hein to transfer \$1,000.00 from the Emergency Fund to be used for the oiling of the streets. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Councilman Hein and seconded by Councilman Hagen that funds be transferred from the Emergency Fund to purchase culvert to run from Highway 101 to Second Street on Easy Street so that the street can be widened and straightened. Motion carried.

A motion was made to adjourn.
