

MINUTES OF SPECIAL MEETING  
OF THE CITY COUNCIL  
OF BROOKINGS, OREGON, HELD  
JULY 15, 1958

THE COUNCIL MET IN SPECIAL SESSION JULY 15, 1958, AT 8:30 P.M.

PRESENT WERE MAYOR CAMPBELL, COUNCILMEN HAGEN, BREUER, AND HEIN, MR. KIRBY AND CHIEF CROSS.

THE MAYOR REPORTED ON HIRING IVAN SMITH AS A BUILDING INSPECTOR AND SUGGESTED THAT HE BE PAID FIFTY PERCENT OF THE BUILDING FEES COLLECTED ON THE PERMITS.

CHIEF CROSS SUBMITTED AN APPLICATION FOR A CLASS A DISPENSERS LICENSE FOR KENNETH TAYLOR AND CLARENCE STOLLER ON A NEW RESTAURANT TO BE BUILT WEST OF THE RESTAURANT. A MOTION WAS MADE BY COUNCILMAN BREUER AND SECONDED BY COUNCILMAN HEIN THAT THE MAYOR BE AUTHORIZED TO APPROVE THE APPLICATION. MOTION CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY.

THE MAYOR ASKED THE COUNCIL'S OPINION ON A EXPENSE ALLOWANCE FOR POLICE OFFICERS. THE COUNCIL RECOMMENDED THAT ATTORNEY BALDERREE BE ASKED TO PREPARE AN ORDINANCE FOR CONSIDERATION BY THE COUNCIL ON THE MATTER.
