MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING

OF THE CITY COUNCIL

OF BROOKINGS, OREGON, HELD

September 16, 1958

The Council met in regular session September 16, 1958, at 8 o'clock p.m.

Present were Mayor Campbell, Councilmen Breuer, Hein and Gulley and others.

A maintenance agreement with Motorola Communications was presented for the council's approval. A motion was made by Councilman Breuer and seconded by Councilman Hein that authorization be given the City Recorder to execute the agreement. Motion carried.

The bills were read as follows:

A motion was made by Councilman Hein and seconded by Councilman Breuer that the bills be paid as read and that the City Recorder give authorization to the American Surety Company to cancel the bond on Pelican Bay Construction Services, Inc. Motion carried. Mr. Lawn from Pelican Bay Construction Services also presented his check in the amount of \$702.91 as payment to the Brookings Water Company and which represented the balance of his outstanding accounts on Sewer Districts 4 and 7.

A plat for the proposed extension of Fern Street was presented. The Council authorized the Mayor to call Mr. Peterson to get his approval on the portion of the street that will run across his property. Councilman Hanks and Bill Spencer were appointed to contact the other property owners to sign a Quitclaim deed for the portion of street that would run through their property. The City Recorder was also instructed to notify the Planning Commission of the Council's intention to extend this street.

Mr. Ackley again discussed at length his proposal for floating a \$250,000 bond issue for the paving of the streets. After considerable discussion, the Mayor appointed Mr. Goetz, Mr. Gulley and R. H. Erichsen to work with him as a committee to investigate the matter of paving streets and arrive at some plan for street paving.

A motion was made by Councilman Breuer and seconded by Councilman Hein that the Mayor and City Recorder be authorized to execute a deed deeding a small portion of property in North Brookings now owned by the City back to the State Highway Department. Motion carried unanimously.

The Mayor informed the Council that the rock crusher being installed by Mr. Bankus near the mouth of the Chetco River is not in violation of the zoning ordinance.

The trailer owned by Wheel Estate Trailer Sales and used for living purposes and an office on their sales lot was discussed. The council took no action on the matter.

A motion was made by Councilman Hein and seconded by Councilman Breuer that the application of Vernon and Emily McDonald for a liquor license not be approved. Motion carried.

R. H. Erichsen presented a plat showing revised areas of assessment in Sewer District No. 8. The Council approved the revised assessment of Sewer District No. 8 as recommended by the engineer.

A motion was made by Councilman Hein that the meeting be adjourned. Earl Breuer seconded the motion.
