

MINUTES OF SPECIAL MEETING  
OF THE CITY COUNCIL  
HELD IN BROOKINGS, OREGON  
ON JANUARY 29, 1959

The council met in special session on January 29, 1959, at 8:00 o'clock p.m.

Present were Mayor Campbell, Councilmen Hanks, Goetz, Phetteplace, and Hein, Recorder Huddleston, Judge Kirby, Chief Cross, Bill Spencer, Engineer Erichson, and others.

Mrs. Curtis was present to discuss her sewer assessment.

A letter from W. H. Brady was read objecting to the assessment on his property in Sewer Area No. 1.

There being no further written or oral objections, the council proceeded with other business.

Resolution No. 42 was read in regard to the paving of Pacific Avenue from Fern Avenue to the "Wye" at Azalea Park Road. A motion was made by Councilman Hanks and seconded by Councilman Phetteplace that the resolution be accepted. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Councilman Hein and seconded by Councilman Goetz that the Mayor and Recorder be authorized to sign an agreement between the State Highway Commission and the City of Brookings for the paving of Pacific Avenue from Fern to the "Wye" at Azalea Park Road. Motion carried unanimously.

Chief Cross suggested that the Taxi Franchise for Arron Rondo be postponed until further investigation could be made. The situation of traffic by the Shell Station and the installation of a traffic island at the intersection of Pioneer and Pacific was discussed. The matter was referred to the Planning Commission for further discussion.

A motion was made by Councilman Hein and seconded by Councilman Goetz that the meeting be adjourned. Motion carried.
