MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING

OF THE CITY COUNCIL

HELD IN BROOKINGS, OREGON,

ON FEBRUARY 10, 1959

THE COUNCIL MET IN REGULAR SESSION ON FEBRUARY 10, 1959, AT 8:00 O'CLOCK P.M.

PRESENT WERE MAYOR CAMPBELL, COUNCILMEN HEIN, PHETTEPLACE AND HANKS, ATTORNEY BALDERREE, RECORDER HUDDLESTON, MR. TOWNSEND, AARON RONDO, H. E. ECHOLS AND MR. HARVEY.

THE MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING HELD ON JANUARY 13, 1959, AND THE HEARING HELD ON JANUARY 29, 1959, WERE READ AND APPROVED.

THREE LETTERS FROM THE PLANNING COMMISSION IN REGARD TO THE PAVING OF CENTER STREET, THE BUILDING PERMIT ISSUED TO NEWELL AND MOORE AND THE STATUS OF THE ROAD TO THE BILL HAMAN PROPERTY WAS READ. FURTHER INVESTIGATION OF THE ROAD TO THE HAMAN PROPERTY WAS TO BE MADE.

A LETTER FROM THE WEST COAST TELEPHONE COMPANY OUTLINING THE CHANGES IN THE TELEPHONE SYSTEM WAS READ.

THE APPLICATION OF TRUMAN ELLIS FOR THE TAXI FRANCHISE WAS PRESENTED. AFTER DISCUSSION, A MOTION WAS MADE BY COUNCILMAN HANKS AND SECONDED BY COUNCILMAN HEIN THAT THE APPLICATION OF TRUMAN ELLIS BE ACCEPTED TO OPERATE A TAXI IN THE CITY OF BROOKINGS. MOTION CARRIED.

A LETTER FROM MR. HARVEY, CIRCULATION MANAGER, OF THE EUREKA NEWSPAPERS, INC. WAS READ, WHICH REQUESTED PERMISSION TO SOLICIT SUBSCRIPTIONS IN BROOKINGS. THE COUNCIL AGREED TO LET HIM SOLICIT FOR SUBSCRIPTIONS IN THE CITY.

THERE WAS SOME DISCUSSION OF PREPARATION OF AN ORDINANCE FOR SEWER HOOKUPS FOR PROPERTY OUTSIDE OF A SEWER DISTRICT.

ORDINANCE NO. 123 AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 31 AND DESIGNATING NUMBERS FOR THE VARIOUS COUNCIL POSITIONS AND REQUIRING THE FILING FOR POSITIONS OF THE COUNCIL BY POSITION NUMBER WAS READ THE SECOND TIME FULLY AND DISTINCTLY AT LENGTH. THEREUPON A MOTION WAS MADE BY COUNCILMAN HEIN AND SECONDED BY COUNCILMAN PHETTEPLACE THAT THE ORDINANCE BE ADOPTED. THE MAYOR ORDERED THAT THE ROLL BE CALLED AND THEREUPON A ROLL CALL UPON THE ADOPTION OF SAID ORDINANCE WAS HAD AND THE VOTE RESULTED AS FOLLOWS:

"ABSENT": COUNCILMAN GOETZ.

ORDINANCE NO. 124, AN ORDINANCE CREATING A SPECIAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT WITHIN THE CITY OF BROOKINGS, ORESON, TO BE KNOWN AS SANITARY SEWER DISTRICT NO. 1, DESIGNATING THE PROPERTY TO BE SPECIALLY BENEFITED BY SAID SANITARY SEWER SYSTEM, LEVYING A SPECIAL ASSESSMENT UPON SAID PROPERTIES, AND PROVIDING FOR THE PAYMENT OF THE COST OF SAID SEWER IMPROVEMENT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY WAS READ THE FIRST TIME FULLY AND DISTINCTLY AT LENGTH. THEREUPON COUNCILMAN HANKS MOVED THAT THE RULES BE SUSPENDED AND AN EMERGENCY DECLARED AND THAT SAID ORDINANCE BE READ THE SECOND TIME BY TITLE ONLY. THIS MOTION

THE Mayor THEN DECLARED THAT SAID MOTION HAD DULY CARRIED AND DIRECTED THAT ORDINANCE No. 124 BE READ THE SECOND TIME BY TITLE ONLY. SAID ORDINANCE WAS THEREUPON READ THE SECOND TIME BY TITLE ONLY.

THEREUPON COUNCILMAN HEIN MOVED THAT THE RULES BE SUSPENDED AND AN EMERGENCY DECLARED AND SAID ORDINANCE BE NOW PASSED TO ITS THIRD READING BY TITLE ONLY AND PLACED UPON ITS FINAL PASSAGE AND BE IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT FROM AND AFTER ITS PASSAGE. SAID MOTION WAS SECONDED BY COUNCILMAN PHETTEPLACE. THE MAYOR THEREUPON STATED THE MOTION AND THE VOTE RESULTED AS FOLLOWS:
