OF THE CITY COUNCIL HELD IN BROOKINGS, OREGON, ON JUNE 9, 1959

THE COUNCIL MET IN REGULAR SESSION AT 8:00 O'CLOCK P.M., JUNE 9, 1959.

PRESENT WERE MAYOR PRO-TEM GOETZ, COUNCILEMN PHETTEPLACE, HEIN AND HANKS, ATTORNEY BALDERREE, BILL SPENCER, CHIEF CROSS, ELMER BANKUS, ROBERT KERR AND BERNICE HUDDLESTON.

A LETTER FROM LEROY WEIDEMAN PROPOSING TO DO CERTAIN REPAIRS ON THE FIRE HALL FOR THE SUM OF \$149.00 WAS READ. A MOTION WAS MADE BY COUNCILMAN PHETTEPLACE AND SECONDED BY COUNCILMAN HANKS THAT MR. WEIDEMAN BE AUTHORIZED TO MAKE THE REPAIRS OUTLINED IN HIS LETTER WITH THE EXCEPTION THAT SHEETROCK BE INSTALLED INSTEAD OF PLYWOOD AND NEW GLASS BE PUT IN THREE WINDOWS INSTEAD OF ONE. MOTION CARRIED.

RECOMMENDATION NO. 57 FROM THE PLANNING COMMISSION REQUESTING THE COUNCIL TO INVESTIGATE THE LEGALITY OF THE CLOSURE OF FIFTH STREET WAS READ.

AFTER CONSIDERABLE DISCUSSION, THE MATTER WAS TABLED FOR FURTHER INVESTIGATION.

PLANNING COMMISSION RECOMMENDATION NO. 59 WAS READ. THE COUNCIL INSTRUCTED THE RECORDER TO RETURN THE RECOMMENDATION TO THE PLANNING COMMISSION FOR FURTHER STUDY.

A MOTION WAS MADE BY COUNCILMAN PHETTEPLACE AND SECONDED BY COUNCILMAN HEIN THAT O. D. ARP BE APPOINTED AS A MEMBER OF THE PLANNING COMMISSION TO FILL THE UNEXPIRED TERM OF GORDON GOETZ, WHO WAS ELECTED AS A MEMBER OF THE COUNCIL. MOTION CARRIED.

A LETTER FROM THE CHETCO COMMUNITY PUBLIC LIBRARY INFORMING THE COUNCIL THAT MRS. C. O. BUSHNELL WAS APPOINTED LIBRARIAN EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 1959, WHICH IS THE RESIGNATION DATE OF THE PRESENT LIBRARIAN, MRS. EDITH HYNES.

A MOTION WAS MADE BY COUNCILMAN HEIN AND SECONDED BY COUNCILMAN HANKS
THAT MACK BOND AND C. H. FINNEY BE GIVEN THE LATERAL IN EXCHANGE FOR AN
EASEMENT ACROSS THEIR PROPERTY FOR THE SCHOOL SEWER. MOTION CARRIED
UNANIMOUSLY.

PAVING AND DILING OF THE STREETS WAS DISCUSSED. THE COUNCIL AGREED THAT BEFORE ANYTHING DEFINITE CAN BE DONE IN REGARD TO PAVING A RESOLUTION MUST BE ADOPTED AND THE ENGINEER INSTRUCTED TO PREPARE THE LEGAL DESCRIPTION AND SPECIFICATIONS ON PAVING.

ROBERT KERR WAS PRESENT TO DISCUSS FIRE PERMITS. MR. BALDERREE WAS INSTRUCTED TO PREPARE AN ORDINANCE ON FIRE PERMITS.

An ordinance to establish finish grades for a portion of Oak Street in the City of Brookings, Oregon, was read the first time fully and distinctly at Length.

MR. BALDERREE DISCUSSED VARIOUS CHANGES OF ORDINANCES TO COMPLY WITH STATE LAWS AND FOR FURTHER CLEARIFICATION.

THE ESTABLISHMENT OF HEIGHT OF CURBS WAS DISCUSSED.
