THE COUNCIL MET IN SPECIAL SESSION ON JULY 17, 1959, AT 8:00 O'CLOCK P.M. FOR THE PURPOSE OF HEARING OBJECTIONS ON THE PROPOSED PAVING DISTRICTS
No. 1 THROUGH 6.

PRESENT WERE MAYOR CAMPBELL, AND COUNCILMEN HEIN/AND GOETZ AND A NUMBER OF PROPERTY OWNERS IN THE VARIOUS PAVING DISTRICTS.

WRITTEN OBJECTIONS IN REGARD TO THE PAVING FROM MRS. MYRTLE BUNNELL, MR. AND MRS. JAMES MARTINDALE, WESLEY C. KINDEL, PAUL JOHNSON, MRS. DON YOUNG, EDWARD MAURER, R. H. HART, MR. AND MRS. E.H. BROCKMILLER AND WILLIAM H. PATE WERE READ.

MR. WILLIAM PATE WAS PRESENT TO PROTEST THE PAVING ASSESSMENT DUE TO THE FACT THAT THE STREET WAS PAVED IN FRONT OF HIS HOME.

GARY WIMBERLEY WANTED TO KNOW THE GRADE ON OAK STREET AND ALSO REQUESTED THE CITY TO INSTALL OUTLETS FROM THE PAVING TO HIS BUSINESS.

GLEN ROGERS WAS PRESENT TO INQUIRE THE GRADE OF OAK STREET IN FRONT OF HIS PROPERTY.

BYRON BRIMM REQUESTED THE CITY TO PROVIDE MORE ADEQUATE DRAINAGE FROM THE STREET IN FRONT OF HIS PROPERTY BEFORE PAVING WAS COMPLETED.

THERE BEING NO FURTHER WRITTEN OR ORAL OBJECTIONS THE COUNCIL PROCEEDED TO DISCUSS OTHER BUSINESS.

A MOTION WAS MADE BY COUNCILMAN PHETTEPLACE AND SECONDED BY COUNCILMAN
HEIN THAT THE MAYOR AND CITY RECORDER BE AUTHORIZED TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT
DATED JUNE 18, 1959, IN REGARD TO AN EASEMENT ON TAX LOTS 28 AND 29, OWNED
BY WARREN McNeeley and Fred Blunt. Motion carried unanimously.

A BID SUBMITTED BY FAIRY CREEK ROCK COMPANY WAS OPENED AND READ, WHICH OFFERED FIVE SACK CONCRETE TO THE CITY FOR THE SEWER OUTFALL LINE AT \$15.85 PER CUBIC YARD. THERE BEING NO OTHER BIDS SUBMITTED, A MOTION WAS MADE BY COUNCILMAN PHETTEPLACE AND SECONDED BY COUNCILMAN HEIN THAT THE BID OF FAIRY CREEK ROCK COMPANY BE ACCEPTED. MOTION CARRIED.

A MOTION WAS MADE BY COUNCILMAN GOETZ AND SECONDED BY COUNCILMAN PHETTEPLACE TO ADJOURN.
