

MINUTES OF PUBLIC HEARING ON 1968-69 BUDGET
CITY OF BROOKINGS
JUNE 24, 1968

Reporters present were Marge Barrett and Dick Keusink.


The hearing was held open for one hour. No public objections to the proposed 1968-69 budget were made.
