The meeting was called to order at 3:05 P. M. by Mayor Bruce J. Manley.


Councilmen present were Lloyd Mosier and Gilbert Batty.

The purpose of this meeting was to open bids for the intake structure of the proposed municipal water system. Two bids had been received. Ranney Method Western Corporation of Kennewick, Washington bid \$56,200. Rex Kimsey Construction Co. of Stayton, Oregon, bid \$56,667. The Council indicated they would make their decision concerning the bids at their regular meeting on May 14. The special meeting was adjourned at 3:25. The bids were also publicly read at 8:00 P. M. on May 10.
