

ORDINANCE NO. 335

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 243 TO REQUIRE THE INSTALLATION OF WATER METERS WITHIN SIXTY DAYS FROM THE DATE OF APPROVAL OF APPLICATION AND PAYMENT FOR SERVICE.

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 243, adopted by the Brookings City Council prescribes regulations for the conduct and operation of the water system of the City of Brookings and connections therewith, regulating and governing the use of water from said system and prescribing penalties; and

WHEREAS, the Brookings City Council desires that water meters be installed within sixty days after the consumer obtains approval of application and makes required payment;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF BROOKINGS ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:


That Section 9, entitled Separate Meters, New Consumers and Extensions, of Ordinance No. 243 of the City of Brookings is hereby amended by adding thereto,

"Subsection: E. The prospective consumer desiring a water meter or meters installed is required to have said meter or meters installed within sixty days from the earlier of the date of City approval of an application or payment for service by the consumer; and further, should said installation not be completed and performed within such sixty-day period, then the approval upon such application shall be null and void and the application shall be of no further effect, and any funds on deposit with or having been paid to the City for said services, shall become the sole and separate property of the City without reimbursement to the applicant."
