

ORDINANCE NO. 332

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCES NO. 306 AND 307 AND TO HAVE THE CITY COUNCIL ELECT A CITY COUNCILMAN TO EACH DEPARTMENT.

THE CITY OF BROOKINGS ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:


WHEREAS, the City Council of Brookings desires to make changes in its form of government to provide greater direct control by the City Council members over the management of the City;

THEREFORE, it is ordered that Ordinances No. 306 and 307 pertaining to the duties of the City Manager are hereby repealed, and that hereafter the City Council shall elect a City Councilman to supervise each city department, and that such City Councilman shall report any irregularities within the department to the City Manager for emergency action, and if the City Manager fails to act the supervising Councilman then may take the necessary action within his assigned department.


BE IT FURTHER ORDERED that the City Council be consulted on all matters pertaining to the hiring or termination of any and all City employees, and further, any employee can be terminated by majority vote of the City Council.

The Brookings City Council hereby deems that the public peace, health and safety of the City of Brookings requires that this Ordinance be immediately adopted and an emergency is therefore declared to exist, and that this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage.
