

ORDINANCE NO. 378

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING RATES, FEES AND OTHER CHARGES TO BE CHARGED FOR SANITARY SEWER SERVICES CONNECTED WITH OR PERTAINING TO THE SANITARY SEWER SYSTEM FACILITIES PROVIDED BY THE CITY OF BROOKINGS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY OF BROOKINGS ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. As of the date of the enactment hereof, the following rates, fees and other charges to be charged by the City of Brookings to the user of any of its sanitary sewer system services or facilities shall be as follows:

(A) The monthly sewer usage rate for each user shall be determined by multiplying the applicable Equivalent Domestic Unit for such users by \$8. The following EDU schedule is assigned for the following categories:

1. Single Family Residence	1 EDU per Unit
2. Multiple Dwelling (Including Duplex, Triplex, Apartment)	1 EDU per Unit
3. Mobile Home Park	1 EDU per Unit
4. Church	1 EDU
5. Retail Store (with Private Restrooms)	1 EDU
6. Retail Store (with Public Restrooms)	2 EDU
7. Service Station	2 EDU
8. School	0.08 EDU per Student & Faculty
9. Office/Commercial	1 EDU - Private Restrooms 2 EDU - Public Restrooms

10. Restaurant	1 EDU - Private Restrooms +2 EDU - Public Restrooms +1 EDU - if less than 25 seats OR +2 EDU - if more than 25 seats
11. Tavern or Lounge (in addition to Restaurant)	2 EDU
12. Public Facility with Private Restrooms	1 EDU
13. Public Facility with Public Restrooms	2 EDU
14. Motel or Hotel	0.2 EDU per Unit
15. Campsites and Overnight Trailer Parks	0.2 EDU per Unit with Restrooms and Showers 0.1 EDU per Unit with Restrooms only
16. Laundromat	0.25 EDU per Washer

(B) Any combination of the above uses on a premises shall be subject to the combined EDU charge.

Section 2. The schedule of such charges set forth herein shall amend, replace and supersede any prior ordinances, provisions or enactments made by the City of Brookings in relation thereto prior to the date of the enactment hereof; and further, where such prior provisions are inconsistent herewith they are herein deemed exclusively overruled and so repealed.

Section 3. It is hereby determined that it is in the interest of public welfare, peace and safety of the City of Brookings that this Ordinance be immediately adopted because the City of Brookings requires forthwith additional funds adequate and necessary to maintain and operate its said public sanitary sewer system services and facilities and therefore an emergency is declared to exist, and that this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage.
