

RESOLUTION NUMBER XIX

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A RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR THE MANNER OF DOING THE WORK CONNECTED WITH SANITARY SEWER IMPROVEMENTS IN CANBY SEWER DISTRICT NO. 4; DIRECTING ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS; AND PROVIDING THE TIME FOR THE COMMENCEMENT OF SUCH WORK.

WHEREAS, the Canby City Council initiated action at a regular meeting of said Council, held on the 17th day of March, 1958 to extend sewer laterals in that part of the City of Canby as requested in the Petitions of property owners filed under the City Engineer's lateral numbers X, X1, X2, O1.2, Z, Q, O1.1 and G-1, and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer for the City of Canby made a survey and written report to the Council of such proposed project as he was authorized to do and filed the same at the office of the Canby City Recorder on the 16th day of June, 1958, and

WHEREAS, said survey and report was duly considered by the Canby City Council at a regular meeting thereof, held on the 16th day of June, 1958 and said report was approved as submitted as more fully shown by the records of the minutes of the Council Meeting on such date, and

WHEREAS, the City Recorder caused a Notice to be published in the Canby Herald and also mailed Notice to each of the property owners within the boundaries of said Sewer District No. 4, notifying them of the proposed Sewer Improvement project, the estimated cost thereof and that remonstrances against such project would be considered by the City Council at a meeting to be held on the 7th day of July, 1958, and

WHEREAS, the remonstrance meeting was regularly held at the time and place provided therefore, and at such meeting the Mayor of the City called for remonstrances by any of the property owners within the boundaries of the proposed sewer improvement


project No. 4, but no objections or remonstrances were made as is more fully shown by the record of the minutes of the Council meeting of July 7th, 1958, whereupon the City Council moved to proceed with said sewer improvements.

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to the action of the Canby City Council heretofore taken, and the provisions of City Ordinance No. 393, it is hereby resolved as follows:


That the Council for the City of Canby proceed immediately with the construction of sanitary sewer improvements in Sewer District No. 4, and that a contract for the work to be done in connection therewith be awarded on bids for the same; and that the City Recorder cause to be published forthwith in the Canby Herald, a newspaper of general circulation printed and published in Canby, Oregon, for two successive issues, an advertisement for bids on said work and according to the City Engineer's plans and specifications for the same. The advertisement for bids shall specify among other things that sealed bids will be received by the said Recorder up to and including the hour of 8:00 o'clock P.M. standard Oregon time on the 13th day of October, 1958, and that immediately thereafter the bids will be publicly opened by the common Council for the awarding of a contract for the work to be done. The advertisement shall also specify that the contract will be awarded to the lowest responsible bidder, provided that the Council shall have the right to reject any and all bids when they are deemed unreasonable or unsatisfactory; that all bidders must be prequalified in accordance with the laws of the State of Oregon; that each proposal must be accompanied by a certified check, cashier's check or bid bond payable to the City of Canby, in an amount not less than five percent (5%) of the amount of the bid; that the successful bidder will be required to furnish security for the performance of the contract in the full amount of the contract price;

that the award of the contract may be postponed for a period not to exceed thirty (30) days; and that the City reserves the right to accept such proposal that is to the best interest of the City of Canby.
