RESOLUTION NO. XXV

IN THE MATTER OF EXTENDING SUPPORT TO THE
SENATE FOREIGN RELATIONS COMMITTEE WITH REGARD
TO RATIFICATION OF THE "CANADIAN TREATY".

WHEREAS, the City of Canby, Oregon is a
contract distributor of electric energy, dis-
pensed by the Bonneville Power Administration;

AND WHEREAS, such distributor is interested
in the continual availability of an unlimited
supply of electric energy;

AND WHEREAS, such distributor desires to be
in the position of maintaining a low electrical
resale rate to its customers;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT, the
City of Canby, Oregon, by the powers vested in
its Common Council, Ordain:

its ~~full~~hearted support to the Senate Foreign
Relations Committee of the United States, in
said committee's deliberation and hearing on
and for the "Ratification of the Canadian Treaty".
