## RESOLUTION NO. XXXVI

A RESOLUTION DETERMINING THE NEED FOR USE OF FUNDS FROM THE LIGHT DEPARTMENT DISASTER FUND; AND AUTHORIZING THE TRANSFER OF NEEDED FUNDS TO THE GENERAL ACCOUNT.

WHEREAS the City of Canby's Light Department suffered serious and extensive damage to its facilities as the result of a typhoon type storm of an uncontrollable force which occurred in the City of Canby and generally throughout the Willamette Valley of Oregon on October 12, 1962; and

WHEREAS the Light Department funds budgeted for normal operation and maintenance of its facilities are inadequate to cover the costs of repairing, restoring and reconstructing the damaged facilities of that department; and the continued and uninterrupted operation of such department is essential to the health, peace, safety and general welfare of the City of Canby and its residents; and

WHEREAS the Canby City Council by Ordinance No. 421 adopted January 5, 1959 provided funds for such a contingency and the need for the use of a part of such funds now exists, now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED by the Canby City Council in regular session convened that:

1. Because of the storm damage to the facilities of the City's Light Department sustained on October 12, 1962 an emergency is hereby declared to exist.

2. It is hereby determined that a need exists for the use of a part of the LIGHT DEPARTMENT DISASTER FUND which was created by City Ordinance No. 421.

3. That the City Recorder and City Treasurer shall, and they are hereby directed, to transfer the sum of  $\frac{12,000}{12,000}$ from the LIGHT DEPARTMENT DISASTER FUND to the City's General Fund for use by the Canby City Council in repairing, reconstructing,

rebuilding, restoring, renewing or remodeling any or all of the facilities which are a part of the city's Light Department and which sustained storm damage on October 12, 1962.
