

RESOLUTION NO. XLIII

A RESOLUTION FIXING A DATE, TIME AND PLACE FOR A PUBLIC HEARING ON THE QUESTION OF WITHDRAWING FROM THE CANBY RURAL FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT THAT PART THEREOF WHICH WAS ANNEXED TO THE CITY OF CANBY BY ORDINANCE NO. 451.

WHEREAS, a part of the Canby Rural Fire Protection District was recently annexed to the City of Canby in accordance with the laws of the State of Oregon and the Ordinances of the City of Canby; and said annexation was concluded by Canby City Ordinance No. 451 adopted by the Canby City Council and approved by the Mayor of said City on the 17th day of June, 1963; and

WHEREAS, the Common Council for the City of Canby has determined and does hereby determine that that part of said Fire District which was annexed to said City by said Ordinance should be withdrawn from said Fire Protection District in the manner set forth in Oregon Revised Statutes 222.524, now therefore

BE IT ~~RESOLVED~~ by the Canby City Council in regular session convened as follows, to-wit:

1. That the Common Council for the City of Canby, a municipal corporation of Clackamas County, State of Oregon, as the governing body of said City does hereby elect to cause the withdrawal from the CANBY RURAL FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT of that part of said District heretofore annexed to the City of Canby by Ordinance No. 451 adopted June 17, 1963, and which said part is particularly described as follows, to-wit:

A part of the Champing Pendleton D.L.C. in Township 3 South, Range 1 East of the Willamette Meridian, in the County of Clackamas and State of Oregon, and being that portion of said D.L.C. lying North of the South lines of Sections 28 and 29 and lying South of the South line of Territorial Road and West of the West line of Riverside Road, also known as Ferry Road.


2. That a public hearing on the question of such withdrawal shall be held at the Canby City Hall, Canby, Clackamas County, Oregon, at 8:00 o'clock p.m. Daylight Saving Time on Monday, September 16, 1963, at which hearing the Canby City Council will hear objections to the withdrawal and shall determine whether such withdrawal is for the best interest of the City.

3. That the Canby City Recorder shall and he is hereby directed to cause a Notice of the date, time, place and purpose of the hearing to be published in the Canby Herald, a newspaper of general circulation printed and published in the City of Canby once each week for two successive weeks prior to the date of hearing; and he shall also cause Notices of the hearing to be posted in four (4) public places in the City of Canby for a like period.
