

RESOLUTION NUMBER L (50)

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE OFFER OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF CLACKAMAS COUNTY, OREGON, TO SURRENDER JURISDICTION OVER CERTAIN ROADS AS DESCRIBED HEREIN.

WHEREAS, it has been considered and deemed necessary and expedient and for the best interests of the City of CANBY, Oregon, that the City of CANBY, Oregon, acquire and accept jurisdiction over certain portion (s) of County Road (s) lying within and adjacent to the corporate limits of said City, as the same is herewith described, and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, pursuant to ORS 373.270, has conducted a public hearing and has deemed it to be expedient and for the best interests of the county to surrender jurisdiction over the County Road (s) herewith described, and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has made an offer to the City of CANBY, Oregon, to surrender jurisdiction over said County Road (s) or portion thereof.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CANBY, Oregon, that by virtue of the foregoing and pursuant to the provisions of ORS 373.270, the City Council of the City of CANBY, Oregon, do and hereby does, accept jurisdiction as offered by the Board of Commissioners of the County of Clackamas, State of Oregon, over the following portion of County Road (s) being described as follows:

A strip of land being generally 60.0 feet in width, lying in Sections 29 and 32, Township 3 South, Range 1 East, of the W.M., and being more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at a point on the south line of the Champing Pendleton Donation Land Claim, which is South 89° 50' 45" West 2068.89 feet from the most easterly southeast corner of said D.L.C.; thence South 89° 39' 25" East 30.0 feet to the true point of beginning; thence North 0° 20' 35" East 940.26 feet; thence on a 12 foot radius curve to the right, a central angle of 78° 20' 25", a distance of 19.40 feet to a point on the south line of the Territorial Road; thence South 78° 41' West along the south line of said Territorial Road 83.32 feet; thence Easterly on a 10 foot radius curve to the right, whose radial point bears South 11° 19' East, through a central angle of 101° 39' 35", a distance of 17.74 feet; thence South 0° 20' 35" West 2355.78 feet; thence on a 12 foot radius curve to the right, through a central angle of 100° 46' 35", a distance of 21.11 feet to a point on the north line of Knights Bridge Road; thence South 79° 13' 25" East along the north line of said Knights Bridge Road 83.86 feet; thence Westerly on a 10.0 foot radius curve to the right, whose radial point bears North 11° 07' 10" East, through a central angle of 79° 13' 25", a distance 13.87 feet to a point on the north and south line between the Albert and Margaret E. Nordlander Tract and the Earl and Sabina Oliver Tract described in Book 596, Page 3, Clackamas County Records of Deeds; thence North 0° 20' 35" East along said Nordlander and Oliver line and its northerly extension 1451.11 feet to the point of beginning. All bearings are from Clackamas County Survey, May, 1962.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor of the City of CANBY, Oregon, be and he is hereby authorized and directed to accept the offer of the Board of Commissioners of Clackamas County, Oregon, to surrender jurisdiction over the portion of the County Road (s) as herein described on behalf of the Council of the City of CANBY, Oregon.
