

RESOLUTION NO. XXXI

RESOLVED: That the terms and conditions of transfer of Federal Surplus property as shown on "Certificate and Agreement" which appear on all instruments of transfer in use by the Surplus Property Section, Services Division, Department of Finance and Administration, shall be spread upon the minutes of this meeting; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That City Councilman Glenn Onion and Fire Chief Norman Christiansen shall be and they are hereby appointed and authorized as the representatives of the City of Canby, a municipal corporation of the State of Oregon, to obligate its funds and obtain the transfer to it of surplus property from said Surplus Property Section upon and subject to the terms and conditions set forth in the said "Certificate and Agreement", a copy of which is attached to the Canby City Council's resolution Number XI, and is now a part of the City's records and files, and in its name and behalf agree to such terms and conditions; and be it


FURTHER RESOLVED: That a certified copy of this Resolution be given to the Surplus Property Section, Services Division, Department of Finance and Administration, and that the same shall remain in full force and effect until written notice to the contrary is given said Surplus Property Section by the City Council for the City of Canby, Oregon.
