

RESOLUTION NO. LVII

A RESOLUTION FIXING A DATE, TIME AND PLACE FOR A PUBLIC HEARING ON THE QUESTION OF WITHDRAWING FROM THE CANBY RURAL FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT THAT PART THEREOF WHICH WAS ANNEXED TO THE CITY OF CANBY BY ORDINANCE NO. 485.

WHEREAS, a part of the Canby Rural Fire Protection District was recently annexed to the City of Canby in accordance with the laws of the State of Oregon and the Ordinances of the City of Canby; and said annexation was concluded by Canby City Ordinance No. 485 adopted by the Canby City Council and approved by the Mayor of said City on the 19th day of July, 1965; and

WHEREAS, the Common Council for the City of Canby has determined and does hereby determine that that part of said Fire District which was annexed to said City by said Ordinance should be withdrawn from said Fire Protection District in the manner set forth in Oregon Revised Statutes 222.524, now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED by the Canby City Council in regular session convened as follows, to-wit:

1. That the Common Council for the City of Canby, a municipal corporation of Clackamas County, State of Oregon, as the governing body of said City does hereby elect to cause the withdrawal from the CANBY RURAL FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT of that part of said District heretofore annexed to the City of Canby by Ordinance No. 485 adopted July 19, 1965, and which said part is particularly described as follows, to-wit:

A tract of land lying and being in Section 28, T. 3 S., R. 1 E., of the W.M., in the County of Clackamas and State of Oregon, described as follows:

Beginning at the southwest corner of Lot 56, Pruneland; running thence South along the southerly extension of the west line of said Lot 56 to a point in the south line of the Territorial Road; thence Northeasterly along the southerly line of said road and the northerly line of Lot 46 Canby Gardens to the northerly terminus of the west line of Amrine Road; thence North to the center line of the Territorial Road; thence North 78° 24' East along said centerline 20 feet, more or less, to an iron pipe set at the southwest corner of that tract conveyed to Mary L. Collins, et al, by deed recorded September

26, 1946, in Deed Book 377, page 429, Records of Clackamas County, Oregon; thence North along the west line of said Collins tract 945 feet, more or less, to the intersection of said west line with the easterly extension of the north line of Lot 54 Pruneland; thence West along said easterly extension and said north line of said Lot 54 Pruneland 660 feet to the northwest corner of said Lot 54; thence South along the west line of Lots 54, 55 and 56 Pruneland to the southwest corner of said Lot 56 and point of beginning.


2. That a public hearing on the question of such withdrawal shall be held at the Canby City Hall, Canby, Clackamas County, Oregon, at 8:00 o'clock p.m., Oregon Daylight Saving Time, on Monday, August 16, 1965, at which hearing the Canby City Council will hear objections to the withdrawal and shall determine whether such withdrawal is for the best interest of the City.

3. That the Canby City Recorder shall and he is hereby directed to cause a Notice of the date, time, place and purpose of the hearing to be published in the Canby Herald, a newspaper of general circulation printed and published in the City of Canby once each week for two successive weeks prior to the date of hearing; and he shall also cause Notices of the hearing to be posted in four (4) public places in the City of Canby for a like period.
