

RESOLUTION NO. LXXI

A RESOLUTION REVISING IN PART THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF ZION CEMETERY.

Pursuant to the authority set forth in Section 1 of Ordinance No. 416 enacted by the Canby City Council July 7, 1958, it is hereby RESOLVED by the Canby City Council in regular meeting convened that the rules and regulations of Zion Cemetery adopted January 10, 1938, and revised July, 1949, are now hereby revised again to provide that:

All monuments and markers must be flat bronze or quarried granite of modern design. Each grave may be marked with a flat bronze marker or with a polished quarried granite marker, and all such markers must be 12" X 24" for adults and 10" X 20" for children and 3" to 6" thick and set level with the ground; letters on bronze markers may be raised but letters on granite markers must be sunk deep; and no foot stones shall be permitted.

Adopted by the Canby City Council this 1st day of April, 1968.
