RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING PURCHASE OF NEW FIRE APPARATUS.

WHEREAS, the City of Canby's Fire Department is in need of a new fire pumper and funds for the purchase of such equipment are now on hand in the City's Fire Department savings account;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of Canby, Clackamas County, State of Oregon, that a new 1,000 gallon per minute fire pumper and miscellaneous equipment be purchased by and for the City of Canby according to the plans and specifications for such equipment which were prepared by the Fire Chief and approved by the City Council at a regular meeting on April 1, 1968.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Recorder cause to be published in the Canby Herald, a newspaper of general circulation printed and published in the City of Canby, County of Clackamas, State of Oregon, a Notice of the proposed purchase specifying that sealed bids will be received by said Recorder up to and including the hour of 8:00 o'clock p.m., Oregon Daylight Time, on Monday, May 6, 1968, and considered by the Canby City Council at 8:00 o'clock p.m. on the same day for the purchase of said equipment. Bids shall be accompanied by a Cashier's Check or a Certified Check of or upon a bank doing business in the State of Oregon in the sum of 10% of the total bid price to be forfeited to the City in case the bidder fails to complete his contract in accordance with the terms of his bid; that bids must show the total cost of the equipment to the City of Canby f.o.b. Canby, Oregon, provided the bid be accepted; and that the City reserves the right to reject any or all bids.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that any purchase under a bid approved by the City Council be paid for from the funds on hand in the City's Fire Department savings account unless optional methods of financing are specified by the successful bidder and approved by the City Council.
