RESOLUTION MAKING APPROPRIATIONS OF UNBUDGETED FUNDS IN THE CEMETERY DEPARTMENT'S GENERAL FUND.

WHEREAS, there is an excess of unappropriated funds in the City's Cemetery General Fund Account, and

WHEREAS, the City's Zion Cemetery is in need of a sprinkler system and other items of equipment for care and maintenance of the cemetery, including building improvements, and

WHEREAS, the Canby City Council has determined that it is necessary to increase the appropriation for capital outlay over the amount originally estimated for the Cemetery Department for capital outlay for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1968, in the sum of \$5,334.00 to acquire a cemetery sprinkler system, a tractor, tent, artificial grass and grave liners and for improvement of the cemetery office building; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED that the unappropriated excess funds in the Cemetery Department's General Fund Account in the amount of \$5,334.00 is hereby appropriated and transferred from the Cemetery Department General Fund Account to the appropriation for capital outlay in the Cemetery Department General Fund.
