

RESOLUTION NO. XC

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING REGULATIONS FOR ANGLING IN WATERS
WITHIN THE BOUNDARIES OF ANY CANBY CITY PARK.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Canby City Council that the following
rules and regulations required to be made by the provisions of
the Fishery Management Ordinance of the City of Canby, Ordinance
No. 525 adopted December 1, 1969, shall be in force on and after
February 1, 1970, and until changed by Resolution of the Canby City
Council.

CITY OF CANBY ANGLING REGULATIONS

OPEN SEASON: April 19 through October 31.

OPEN WATERS: All waters within the boundaries of the
Canby City Park.

BAG AND POSSESSION LIMITS: Ten (10) fish per person per day.

SIZE LIMITS: Six (6) inches minimum length and no limit
on maximum length.

SPECIES: Any game fish stocked in the waters of the Canby
City Park.

ANGLING HOURS: From one-half hour before sunrise to one-
half hour after sunset.

AGE LIMITS FOR ANGLERS: Boys and girls thirteen (13) years
of age and under.

ALL ANGLERS SHOULD ACQUAINT THEMSELVES WITH THE PROVISIONS
OF THE FISHERY MANAGEMENT ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF CANBY,
ORDINANCE NO. 525 ADOPTED DECEMBER 1, 1969.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the foregoing angling regulations
be published in the Canby Herald once a week for two (2) successive
publications commencing with the first publication on Thursday, the
8TH day of JANUARY, 1970.

Unanimously adopted by the Canby City Council at a regular
meeting thereof on the 5th day of January, 1970.
