A RESOLUTION GRANTING A PERMIT TO THE BOY SCOUTS FOR USE OF CITY PARK.

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Canby, Clackamas County, State of Oregon, as follows:

That a permit be issued, and it is hereby granted to Canby Scout Troop No. 258 and Explorer Post No. 713 to construct and use for scouting purposes an "A" frame shelter building in the southeast corner of the City's park on the Molalla River and for a period of ten (10) years, i.e., until June 1, 1980, providing that the Troop and Post and their leaders, advisors and sponsors comply with all lawful rules and regulations of the Canby City Park Department and/or Ordinances of the City of Canby which relate thereto and which are now existing or hereafter established.
