

RESOLUTION NO. CXIV

A RESOLUTION RELATING TO FRESH AND PLASTIC FLOWERS AT ZION MEMORIAL PARK.

BE IT RESOLVED that during the mowing season and except on the traditional Memorial Day, Mother's Day, Father's Day and the two (2) days immediately preceding and the two (2) days immediately following those days, no fresh or plastic flowers shall be permitted to remain in Zion Memorial Park between the hours of 8:00 o'clock a.m. Monday until 5:00 o'clock p.m. Thursday.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that after August 1, 1971, and during each mowing season thereafter, fresh or plastic flowers which are left in Zion Memorial Park in violation of these regulations shall be deemed abandoned by the owners, and the City's work force shall have authority to dispose of such items without liability to the City or any of its officers or employees.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that notice of these regulations shall be published in the Canby Herald immediately and then prior to each mowing season hereafter, and they shall become effective August 1, 1971, and remain in effect thereafter until changed by the Council.
