

RESOLUTION NO. CXCI (193)

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF CONTRACTS FOR CONSTRUCTION OF IMPROVEMENTS TO N. E. SECOND STREET.

WHEREAS, the improvement of N. E. Second Street in the City of Canby, Oregon, is required and will consist of approximately 1547 lineal feet of residential street construction, including storm sewer construction, grading, subgrade preparation, concrete curbs, base rock and asphalt pavement; and

WHEREAS, the property owners on N. E. Second Street in the vicinity of the aforementioned planned improvements have previously requested the City Council to make such improvements, and said property owners have assumed and agreed to pay the total construction costs, less \$4,273, engineering costs to be paid by the City of Canby, and each owner has agreed to pay the City Recorder his proportionate share of such costs; and

WHEREAS, plans and specifications for the aforementioned improvements of N. E. Second Street have been prepared by the City's Public Works Department and calls for bids for the construction of said improvements was duly advertised in the Canby Herald, a newspaper of general circulation printed and published in Canby, Clackamas County, Oregon, on July 25 and August 2, 1975, and bids were opened and considered on August 11, 1975; and


WHEREAS, the lowest and best bid was that of Parker Northwest Paving Company for a bid price of \$35,154.00; and

WHEREAS, the successful bidders are ready, willing and able to proceed with the construction contract in accordance with the plans, specifications and proposals for said project, and it is necessary that a formal contract be approved and executed by said contractors and the City of Canby; now, therefore,


BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council for the City of Canby

Clackamas County, Oregon, that the bid proposal of Parker North-West Paving Company for the construction of N. E. Second Street improvement project and for the total bid price of \$35,154.00, is hereby approved and accepted; and the Mayor and the City Recorder are hereby authorized and direct to make, execute and deliver in the name of and on behalf of the City of Canby appropriate construction contract with said contractor, and that the bid price for the project be paid upon receipt of billings and approval by the City's Public Works Department and the City Council with the funds on hand and which will be paid to the City for such purposes by the benefited property owners.
