A RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR A SPECIAL ELECTION TO BE HELD IN THE CITY OF CANBY, CLACKAMAS COUNTY, OREGON, ON THE 17TH DAY OF MARCH, 1976, FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUBMITTING TO THE QUALIFIED LEGAL VOTERS OF SAID CITY THE QUESTION OF A GENERAL OBLIGATION BOND ISSUE FOR SWIMMING POOL AND PARK PURPOSES.

BE IT RESOLVED, that the City of Canby, Clackamas County, State of Oregon, call a Special City Election to be held at the City Hall in said City on Wednesday, the 17th day of March, 1976, between the hours of 8:00 o'clock a.m. and 8:00 o'clock p.m., Pacific Standard Time, for the purpose of submitting to the qualified legal voters of said City, pursuant to the Canby City Charter and the City's Initiative and Referendum Ordinance No. 380, the question of contracting a general obligation bonded indebtedness in the name of the City in the sum of ONE HUNDRED TWENTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$120,000) for a term of three (3) years for the purpose of providing funds with which to purchase, repair and improve the swimming pool facilities of Canby Community Pool, Inc. and refund the City for acquisition costs of land purchased for outdoor recreation areas and facilities known as Marshall and Erland properties.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that there shall be only one polling place, i.e., the Canby City Hall, and the City Recorder shall appoint a Chairman and three (3) Clerks as an Election Board to conduct said election, and the Recorder shall furnish the said Board prior to 8:00 o'clock a.m. on Wednesday, March 17, 1976, ballots, ballot boxes and all other necessary paraphernalia and election supplies as may be required for said election.
