RESOLUTION NO. CXCVIII (198)

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT FOR SLUDGE REMOVAL FROM THE CITY'S SEWAGE TREATMENT PLANT.

WHEREAS, the accumulation of sludge at the City's sewage treatment plant poses a problem which has resulted in a determination by the Oregon Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) that it be removed subject to certain requirements; and

WHEREAS, Theodore Zacher has land for a disposal site which is tentatively approved by DEQ for the City's use, and Mr. Zacher has indicated his willingness to remove the City's sewage sludge for use on his land in accordance with the requirements of DEQ, and a Contract between him and the City is required. A proposed Contract for such purposes is attached to this Resolution marked Exhibit "A" for identification purposes and requires Council authority for its execution; now, therefore, the Canby City Council hereby

RESOLVES that the proposed Contract (attached Exhibit "A") between the City of Canby and Theodore Zacher for sewage sludge removal from the City's sewage treatment plant is hereby approved, and the Mayor and City Recorder are hereby authorized and directed to make, execute and deliver said Contract on behalf of the City of Canby; and also make any changes in said Contract which may be advised by the City Attorney and/or required by DEQ in order to accomplish the intent and purpose of the proposed Contract.
