


A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING TRANSFER OF FUNDS IN BUDGET FOR PURCHASE OF RADIO EQUIPMENT FOR POLICE DEPARTMENT AND REPLACEMENT OF FUNDS USED FOR PURCHASE OF NEW FIRE TRUCK.

IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the Canby City Council that an emergency exists requiring a transfer of funds in the City's current budget for purchase of radio equipment for the Canby Police Department, and to replace funds used from another account for the purchase of a new fire truck. The City Recorder/Manager is therefore hereby authorized and directed to purchase the required radio equipment for the Canby Police Department and is also authorized to transfer funds from the Contingency Fund in the amount of \$2,739.00 to the Police Department Capital Outlay Fund for said purchase; and he is further authorized to transfer the sum of \$15,865.96 from the Fire Equipment Special Fund to the Motor Pool Reserve Fund to replace funds used for the purchase of a new fire truck.
